Cornelius be transferred from Extra Office Deputy to Crew Leader of the Real Estate Survey, and Fred C. Cutburth be transferred from Measurer to Crew Leader of the Real Estate Survey, in the office of the County Assessor, both at a salary of \$250.00 per month, and effective April 1, 1950. Also that the appointment of Clem Steen as Office Clerk for the Real Estate Survey at a salary of \$200.00 per month, effective April 17, 1950; also Clyde M. Winterringer as office Clerk on the Real Estate Survey, at a salary of \$200.00 per month, effective April 24, 1950, be and the same are hereby approved.
