It having been found that the width of the ~~Tulsa-Sapulpa~~ paving on the Tulsa-Sapulpa highway being but 9 feet, and that said width would be insufficient to properly accomodate traffic it was moved by Cyrus S.Avery that the width of said road should be increased from 9 feet to 16 feet. The County Clerk is ordered to notify ~~that~~ the contractor and engineer of the change. Proportioned increase in the contract price should be allowed the contractor for the increased width, as per contract.

A petition presented by twelve free holders of West Tulsa and vicinity asking that the road-way on the North side of the Frisco right-of-way and the Section line 11 and 14, in the town of West Tulsa be vacated and a contract filed with the Board of Commissioners to sell said right-of-way to the Frisco Railroad Company being represented to the Board of County Commissioners and the citizens of West Tulsa protesting against said vacation of said section line, said citizens being represented by J.R.League, Attorney. After listening to the argument of the petitioners it was ordered by the Board of County Commissioners that said right-of-way be granted the Frisco Railroad for their exclusive purpose and the contract fulfilled and all papers therein filed was signed by the Board of County Commissioners, consisting of Cyrus S.Avery, Chairman, A.W.Lucas, and Ed.Baker.
