The Bids previously opened on April 24, 1950, were taken under consideration, and upon a motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, <sup>that</sup> the John K. Taylor Company be, and is hereby awarded the contract for 150 30" x 30" Octagon road signs at a price of \$7.20 each, f. o. b. Tulsa, as set out in their Bid. Signs to have two additional horizontal bars, "STOP" not embossed, with Signal Silver Scotchlite. Delivery to be made within approximately two weeks from this date.
