MONDAY, OCTOBER 19th, 1942.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, October 19th, 1942, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Curtis Greer, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the Depository Agreement between the National Bank of Tulsa and the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in the amount of \$510,000, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the Depository Agreement between the First National Bank & Trust Company and the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in the amount of \$500,000, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Wm. Stansbury, Supt. of the County Farm, deposited on October 16th, 1942, with the County Treasurer \$10.00 collected for the sale of a road grader. Receipt No. 21811. same was ordered filed.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the report filed by the Clerk of Water Improvement District No. 5, Dawson, Oklahoma, covering the period July 1, 1942 to September 30, 1942, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
