Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

No official business to be transacted, arecess is hereby taken until 2:00 o'clock P.M.

AFTER RECESS 2:00 o'clock P.M.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P.M., with all members present and presiding as before.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the monthly report of E. A. Watterfield, Court Clerk, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment of the Puritan Corporation, covering deficiency judgments in the amount of \$207.83, be and the same is hereby approved, and the County Clerk is instructed to issue a certificate of error in the above amount. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion is by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment of Ben Schlanger covering realstate for the year 1934 in the amount of \$55.75 be denied for the reason that the County Commissioners have no jurisdiction over refunds. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that Dr. W. E. Smith, Sand Springs, Okla., be and he is hereby appointed county physician at a salary of \$75.00 per month and \$10.00 for each obstetric case, service to begin July 15th, 1935 and continue from month to month until otherwise notified. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Mr. John H. Miller deposited with the County Treasurer on July 16th, 1935 the sum of \$149.00 money collected from patients in the colored Municipal Hospital. Receipt for same is hereby ordered filed.
