ORDER

This matter coming on for hearing before the Honorable Board of County Commissioners, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, on this 7th day of October, 1946, upon the petition of twelve freeholders residing in the vicinity of the road hereinafter described, and the petitioners appearing by their attorney, Joseph A. Moran, the Honorable Board of County Commissioners made the following findings:

1. That on August 30, 1946, a petition was filed with the Honorable Board of County Commissioners, signed by Warren W. Lepley and eleven other freeholders residing in the vicinity of the road hereinafter described.
