

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 22nd, 1920.

Pursuant to adjournment the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, met at the hour of 2 o'clock P. M. In the office of the county Clerk. Present in person: W. L. North, F. M. Wooden and Ed Dalton and Lewis Clige, County Clerk and ex Officio, Secretary of the Board.

A motion was made by F. M. Wooden and seconded by W. L. North that the bids on the County Farm be returned and that the County Clerk be authorized to readvertise for bids to be opened Monday December 6th, 1920. Motion carried.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that the certified check of Davis & Dunn, accompanying bid of said contractor for the improvement of Section W.1, of the State Road System of Tulsa County be returned, said contractor having filed contract with the board and bond for the faithful performance of the work under said contract, which contract and bond were duly approved by the Board. Motion prevailed.

Motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that the County Engineer be instructed to advertize for bids for the grading, draining and otherwise improving Miles 1 A and 2 A of Section "L" of the State Road System of the County of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Affidavits of Erroneous Assessment were filed by A. T. Challbury and J. B. Powell which were by the Board ordered "Stricken from Record."

There being no further business coming before the Board for consideration on this date, on motion of Ed Dalton, the Board adjourned to meet in its next regular session on Monday, December 6th, 1920.
