A special meeting of the Board of County Commissioners was called by the County Clerk, Andy Stokes, at the hour of 11:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

Chairman Miller presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that since the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, finds that the bid of Foster to be Construction Company for the construction of the Snake Creek School/is the lowest bid which complies with the contract and the Statutes of this State, same is hereby accepted and the contract let to the Foster Construction Company for the sum of \$13,480.00 with the understanding that bond of sufficient securities as required by Section 7662, 0.S. 1931 be furnished by Foster Construction Company. It is understood that Alternate No. 1 mentioned in the bid is to have no effect in this contract. WPA labor is not considered in this contract. The roll was called - all voted Aye, motion carried and the contract is let to Foster Construction Company.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the application for re-assessment of unpaid ad valorem taxes filed by J. B. Foster covering Lot 4, Block 150, O.T., be approved, i. e., the assessed valuation be reduced to \$15,000 for the years 1930 to 1935, inc., and the County Clerk is hereby directed to issue a Certificate of Error directing the County Treasurer to cancel the taxes and to issue a Certificate of Assessment re-assessing the within property, provided, however, that the Certificate of Error and the Certificate of Assessment re-assessing said property shall not be issued until the expiration of ten days from the date of this order and provided further that said Certificate of Assessment shall not be issued if any protest be filed within said ten day period until the issued of said protest be determined. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Hopkines, Yes; Gray, Yes; Miller, Yes. Motion carried.

WHEREUPON, at the hour of 12:00 o'clock Noon, a recess is hereby taken until Tuesday, September 7th, 1937, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M.
