Ave. from U.S. 75 and 166th St. N. to U.S. 75 and 116 E. Ave, amounting to \$20,347.88; Project 1-H - 166th Street N. from U.S. 169 to 116th E. Ave; amounting to \$9,620.24; Project No. 3-B - 21st Street from Memorial Ave. to 116th East Avenue, amounting to \$1,859.57; And Standard Paving Company estimates on Project 2-B - Sand Springs Road Bruner Hill to Paving in Place on McKinley Avenue at Sand Springs, amounting to \$9,800.34 and Standard Paving Company's estimate on Project 2-D - Sky Line Road from the Paving in Place, south of U.
