Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the Petition of the Public Service Company be accepted, and that the following Resolution be, and the same is hereby adopted, upon the recommendation of the County Engineer:

"WHEREAS, the Public Service Company of Oklahoma has requested the Board of County Commissioners to grant permission to said Company to establish a pole line carrying cross arms and electric wires for the transmissioner of electric current along certain highways in the County, more particularly described as follows:

To build a rural 6900 volt electric line along the East Side Section 18, Township 17 North, Range 14 East and along North Side Section 20, Township 17 North, Range 14 East.

Said line to be eighteen feet West of Section Line in road ditch just outside fences, which are eighteen and five tenths feet West of Section Line along East Side Section 18, Township 17 North, Range 14 East and along North side Section 20, Township 17 North, Range 14 East, said line to be twenty three feet South of Section Line.

Along the East Side Section 18, Township 17 North, Range 14 East, we have met with opposition to set at our regular distance of twenty three feet from Section Line as it will fall in fields approvimately five feet.

This road is not open full width of forty-nine and five tenths feet. This line serves five rural customers. and

WHEREAS, it appears that said petition should be granted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that permission be, and the same is hereby given the Public Service Company of Oklahoma, to construct, operate and maintain a pole line with cross arms and wires for the transmission of electric current on the public highways above described; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said pole line be constructed in a substantial manner and properly maintained at the border of said highways, in such manner as not to interfere with public travel or the use of said highways.
