RESOLUTION, DECLARING THE NECESSITY, (ON ACCOUNT OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH, CONVENIENCE AND WELFARE OF TULSA COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT NO. 12) TO CAUSE TO BE CONSTRUCTED WITHIN SAID DRAINAGE DISTRICT, A CERTAIN TIMBER TRESTLE BRIDGE OVER AND ACROSS NECESSARY DRAINAGE DITCHES, IN SAID DRAINAGE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, it is necessary, in order to promote the public health, convenience and welfare, of Tulsa County Drainage District No. 12, to cause to be constructed a certain timber trestle bridge over and across a certain drainage ditch in said drainage district, at the point of the crossing of the Tulsa-Sapulpa Union Railway Company tract and the new Cherry Creek channel of Tulsa County Drainage
