Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, on the 18 day of Dec, 1916, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, in regular session, directed the County Engineer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to draw up a map of certain roads in Tulsa County, Oklahoma for the purpose of recommending them as state-highways, marked Sections A. to Z.

AND WHEREAS, the County Engineer of said County, pursuant to said directions, did draw up said map and file same with the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, which said map is now on file with said Clerk;

AND WHEREAS, thereafter, the Board of County Commissioners directed said County Engineer to draw up a profile designating improvements to be made on Sections C.B. I G.Y ZA.1 and W. which said profiles was by said County Engineer drawn up and filed with the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, pursuant to said direction of said Board of County Commissioners;

AND WHEREAS, the said profile of improvements to be made on said Sections last above named was accepted and approved by said Board, and the County Engineer directed and authorized to proceed with the improvements as therein directed;

AND WHEREAS, there now seems to be no record of the resolutions, motions and proceedings of said Board of County Commissioners as herein above set forth;
