

At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners held in the office of said Commissioners, in the City of Tulsa, on the 3rd. day of August, 1925, the following Resolution was introduced by W L North, who moved for its adoption and the motion to adopt was duly seconded by Ed W Hedgecock, and the Resolution ordered read:

R E S O L U T I O N.

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to this Board that there are some irregularities existing in the office of one Tom N Griffith, Justice of the Peace within and for District No. 4, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Honorable Geo. J. Mechling, State Examiner and Inspector be and he is hereby requested and authorized to make an audit of the office of the said Justice of the Peace.

In the matter of the application of The Sand Springs Home for permission to erect and maintain poles, wires and equipment for the transmission of electricity over the public Highways the following order was made:

O R D E R.

Now, On this 3rd. day of August 1925, the petition of Sand Springs Home, a corporation, asking permission and consent of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for the use of the public highway hereinafter described, for the erection thereon of poles, wires and equipment for the transmission of electricity for light, heat and power purposes, coming on to be heard, and the Board of County Commissioners having examined said petition and being fully advised in the premises, finds, that the Sand Springs Home is a corporation, duly chartered under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, and is authorized by its charter to transmit, furnish and sell electricity for light, heat and power purposes, and that it is necessary that it have the use of the public highway hereinafter described, for erecting and constructing thereon, poles, wires and apparatus for the transmission of electricity for light, heat and power purposes.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County Oklahoma, that Sand Springs Home, an Oklahoma Corporation of Sand Springs, Oklahoma, be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to, and consent is hereby given for it to have the use of the following described public road and highway, situate in Tulsa County Oklahoma for the purpose of erecting thereon, poles or posts, on which are to be placed wires and other apparatus and equipment for the purpose of transmitting and selling electricity for light, heat and power, to-wit:

Along the paved road or highway, beginning at a point on the
Section line between Sections 29 and 32, Township 22 North,

Range 14 East, where said paved road leading to Collinsville
