MONDAY, NOVEMBER 7th, 1938.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, November 7th, 1938, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the report filed by Andy Stokes, County Clerk, for the month of October, 1938, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the report filed by Edward F. Jones, Clerk, Court of Common Pleas, ^{for month of Oct. 1938,} be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the report filed by A. Garland Marrs, Sheriff, for boarding of prisoners for the month of October, 1938, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the report filed by the County Court for the month of October, 1938, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that a Quit Claim Deed be issued from the Board of County Commissioners to the Trustees for the Former Stockholders of the Tulsa Building and Loan Association of Record July 10th, 1935, on Lot 2, Block 3, Norvell Park Addition to Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the reason that said property was sold in error; all delinquent taxes having been paid prior to the date of re-sale. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that a Quit Claim Deed be issued from the Board of County Commissioners to the Atlas Life Insurance Company on East Half Lot 29, Block 4, Berry Addition to Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the reason that said property was sold in error; all delinquent taxes having been paid prior to the re-sale. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
