RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Charles G. Brixey was charged with the crime of Abandonment of Minor Children in the Court of Common Pleas Case No. 59095; his bond was fixed at \$500.00, and on March 14th, 1950, he defaulted in his appearance under said bond and said bond was ordered forfeited; and

WHEREAS, the County Attorney brought suit upon said bond forfeiture in District Court Case No. 80,273 against said Charles G. Brixey and his sureties; and one of said sureties, J. D. Scaggs, has offered to settle said bond forfeiture for the sum of \$275.00, which offer the County Attorney recommends this Board accept.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT Elmer W. Adams, County Attorney, is authorized to settle above mentioned bond forfeiture for the sum of \$275.00, plus the costs in the civil case, and said Elmer W. Adams is authorized to keep as his statutory fee one-fourth of \$275.00, or \$63.75, and to pay the balance, or \$211.25, into the office of the Clerk of the District Court.
