

crosses and intersects said Section Line, thence North along said paved highway through Section 29, Township 22, North, Range 14 East, to the Southern Boundary of the Town of Collinsville.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that said poles, wires and apparatus be placed along said paved highway in such manner as to least interfere with the public use of said highway, and subject to the approval of the County Engineer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and that said highway shall not be closed or obstructed and that after placing said poles and wires on said highway, Sand Springs Home, will, at its own expense, place said highway in the same condition of repair as nearly as possible, as it was prior to said construction and installation. And in the event the County Commissioners decide to widen or change said highway, said Sand Springs Home will, at its own expense, move said poles, wires and equipment so as to conform to said change or widening of said highway. The construction of said highline to be subject to the approval and to be erected under the supervision of the County Engineer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and any change or re-location to be also subject to the supervision of the County Engineer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, Sand Springs Home agreeing at all times to hold Tulsa County harmless from liability to third persons arising from any negligence in the construction and maintenance and operation of said poles, wires and apparatus.
