The petition of J Wright Young, and others, praying for the creation of a Water Improvement District, was introduced by Mr.North and seconded by Mr. Hedgecock, and was ordered filed by the County Clerk. The County Clerk was instructed to publish a Notice of Hearing to the owners of lands in the District contemplated to be formed and to others interested, said notice to be published in the Tulsa Tribune on the 5th. day of January, 1928 and such hearing to be held by the Board of County Commissioners at the Court House in Tulsa County on the 16th. day of January, 1928. Upon motion of Mr.North seconded by Mr.Hedgecock, the Bond of Elmer Mercer, et al, for the payment of all expenses growing out of the aforesaid petition was ordered approved and filed.

Motion was made by Mr.North, seconded by Mr.Stuckey, that the Bid of the Standard Paving Company on the County's part of the construction of Water Line to the County Farm be and the same is hereby rejected and the Check is ordered returned.

Motion was made by Mr.North, seconded by Mr.Hedgecock, that Mr.Roach be given the contract for construction of ditch and back-fill on the water-line to County Poor Farm on his bid of \$.17¢.

Nothing further to come before the meeting, same is hereby adjourned until Monday, January 9th. 1928, at 9 o'clock A.M.
