Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that on the recommendation of the County Engineer, the Contract on Project No. 3-G, which covers the Improving, and Surfacing of County Highway from Jenks Bridge Connection, to Sheridan Road, a distance of 4.303 Miles, be and hereby is awarded to the Standard Paving Company who made the low bid, \$58,591.38.

Adams, County Attorney, requesting permission and approval of this Board to settle the judgment of \$5,000.00 heretofore rendered in the case of the State of Oklahoma vs. Robert Lowell Rogers, et al., case No. 77,014, District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and the Board being fully advised in the premises, finds:

That Geo. Abdo and Lillian Abdo were sureties on an appeal bond in the sum of \$5,000.00. That said matter is now in judgment and has been appealed and that the sureties Geo. Abdo and Lillian Abdo have offered to settle said judgment in the sum of \$2,000.00 and the Board being fully advised are of the opinion that said offer is fair, equitable and just and should be accepted.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Elmer W. Adams, County Attorney, is hereby authorized to accept the sum of \$2,000.00 in full settlement of the judgment rendered in case No. 77,014 and to deduct twenty-five per cent of said amount for his fee as allowed by law, and pay the balance into the Court Clerk's Office of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
