herein provided; upon such expiration of ten (10) days from the period of publication the Board of County Commissioners shall open such bids and award the said real estate to the highest and best bidder for the same; provided that such real estate shall not be sold for less than Eighty (80%) percent of its appraised value as reported to the Board of County Commissioners by the appraisers appointed by one of the Judges of the District Court of Tulsa County; provided, however, that the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, shall have the power to reject any and all bids.

Section 5. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, by reason whereof this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption.

ADOPTED, and the emergency clause ruled upon separately, and approved this 12th day of April, 1940.
