

The following resolution was presented by Ed Dalton who moved its adoption, and the same was duly seconded by F. M. Wooden.

Be It Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County in session this 6th day of December, 1920, that whereas funds are available for the grading and draining of Miles one (1) and two (2) of Section "Fl", miles 1 a and 2 a of section "L", and mile five (5) of section M", and miles 3, 4, 5 and 6 of section "P", Tulsa County State Highway.

Now Therefore Be It resolved that the County Engineer be instructed to prepare plans and estimates, advertise for bids for the work to be done and performed.

The above resolution being voted upon as follows:-

This being the date set for the receiving of bids on the construction of the Tulsa County Home, the clerk announced that all bids were in, and ready for the consideration of the Board. The chairman read the bids before the Board of County Commissioners in open session, and on final consideration, a motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by F. M. Wooden that the contract for the construction of said County Home be awarded I. J. Buck, said contractor to file contract and bond with the board, for the faithful performance of the work under said contract. The building to be constructed of Matt face brick, and hollow tile. Said work to be completed on or before June 1st, 1921, or pay to the county of Tulsa, the sum of \$25.00 per day as liquidated damages for each working day thereafter until work is completed. Said proposal being as follows to wit: Tulsa, Okla., December 6, 1920.

Gentlemen:-

I propose to erect building on Bermuda Lawn Farm according to plans and specification submitted by M. C. Cross, Architect, stone building complete including plumbing and heating and gas fittings for the sum of Sixty One Thousand Four Hundred Twelve (\$61,412.00) Dollars.

Brick Building complete including all plumbing and heating and gas fittings for the sum of Sixty Three Thousand (\$63,000) Dollars. If plumbing heating and gas fittings are omitted deduct the sum of Eleven Thousand Three Hundred Dollars.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that the certified checks accompanying the proposals of the unsuccessful bidders be returned. Motion carried.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that the contract for the grading of Miles 1a, 2a and 3a, of Section "W1" of the State Highway system of the County of Tulsa be awarded J. E. Collins, said contractor to file contract and bond with the Board of County Commissioners for the faithful performance of the work under said contract. Motion carried.

A motion was made by F. M. Wooden and seconded by W. L. North that all other checks accompanying bids of the above work be returned. Motion prevailed.

SNAKE CREEK BRIDGE.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by F. M. Wooden that the contract for the construction of the Snake Creek Bridge on section "W1", Section 32, township 17 north, Range 14 East, of the State Highway System of Tulsa County, according to plans, profiles and specifications filed by Dan W. Patton, County Engineer, said contractor to file contract and bond with the Board of County Commissioners for the faithful performance of the work under said contract. Motion carried. A motion to return all other checks accompanying bids for this work was made and duly passed by the Board. Said bridge to be Type #2, to be constructed for the sum of \$17,700.00.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that the contract for the construction of the culverts and bridges on Section "A1" of the State Highway system of the County of Tulsa be awarded A. B. Bancroft, contract and bond to be filed with the Board of County Commissioners for the performance of work under the contract. Motion carried. This being the only bid filed, but within the engineers estimate.

It is moved by W. L. North and seconded by F. M. Wooden that that application for additional and supplemental appropriation in the general fund for the County of Tulsa, and for the general fund of the towns of Jenks be approved, and same is ordered prepared and submitted to the Excise Board of Tulsa County as by law required.
