Resolution  
selling Oil  
& Gas lease  
to A.R.Thomas

The following resolution offered by Mr. W. L. North:

"Be it resolved that we, the duly elected, qualified and acting County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Okla., at this our regular monthly session, do hereby lease, for oil & gas purposes to A. R. Thomas, the following described lands, the same being the property of the said Tulsa County, to-wit:

A certain tract of land situate in the Southwest corner of Lot 4, in Sec. 31, T. 18 N., R. 13 E., said lands extending in a northerly direction from the point of intersection of the section lines at said Southwest corner, a distance of 16 rods, thence in an Easterly direction a distance of 10 rods, thence in a Southerly direction a distance of 16 rods, thence in a westerly direction to the said point of beginning, containing, in all, one (1) acres, more or less.

The consideration of the said lease being the some of \$25.00 bonus, in hand paid, receiptwhereof is hereby acknowledged, and 1/8 royalty in and to all oil which may be found therein and \$250.00 per year for each gas well drilled thereon.

Seconded by Mr. Woolley, Resolution prevailed.
