Gentlemen:-

There was appropriated for our use by the County for this fiscal year, the amount of \$2,000 which was less than the amount given us last year. We had been lead to believe that our appropriation would have been increased rather than decreased, and accordingly planned a campaign for the county that will have to be curtailed if further funds are not forthcoming.

There is an immense amount of work to be done in Sand Springs, Skiatook, Collinsville, Broken Arrow and Jenks before hot weather sets in that we will be unable to do without further assistance. Our budget in the county at the present time runs about \$5,000 per year, which is received from private subscriptions in the City, other than that given by the County.

You are thoroughly enough in touch with the work that we are doing to understand that curtailment of the work especially at the start of the hot season would not be proper, and I am writing you hoping that a further appropriation of \$2,000 can be made that will eliminate the necessity of this curtailment.
