8. Limit the use to 100 days of operation, for the water related activities.

9. That the water theme park not be in operation during the Tulsa State Fair(permit indoor games but no outdoor rides).

10. Noise level readings be established for the park and a maximum noise level be adhered to. Decibel level to be taken at curbside.

11. Free parking shall be provided for users of the park.

Young expressed concern with having loud speakers for any reason within the Water Park. Harris will check to see if there are reasons to have these.

Young suggested that "site plan" be changed to "sketch plan" because the term "site plan" would no be used until after a contract is signed for the Water Park and final approval is sought for the project

Discussion was held regarding the hours of operation of the Water Park and no decision was reached

Discussion was held regarding whether the arcade portion of the Water Park should remain open during the fair. No decision was reached.

It was generally agreed that the Water Park would open no earlier that May 15, and remain open until the day before Preview Day at the Tulsa State Fair.

The Board agreed to carry over other items on the Agenda to the February 15 Management Conference meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 12:00 p.m.
