RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma has heretofore recovered judgment for the use and benefit of Tulsa County in a large number of cases arising out of the forfeiture of criminal appearance bonds covering a period of several years last past, and

WHEREAS, by reason of the lapse of time between the execution of said appearance bonds and reducing the same to judgment, the disposing of the property scheduled by the Sureties on said bonds, and by death and removal from the State, many of said judgments are of doubtful or little value, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff of Tulsa County has exhausted all reasonable means in conjunction with the County Attorney towards the collection or realizing upon said judgments, and it is the opinion and judgment of this Board that if any amounts are to be recovered upon a large number of said judgments it will be only
