

MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE
Thursday, April 11, 1985

The Board of County Commissioners for Tulsa County met at the hour of 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: Lewis Harris, Chairman; Mel Rice and John Selph, Members. Others present: Wayne Carr, Mike Kimbrell and Carol Miller.

Lewis Harris, Chairman, presiding, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and the following business was transacted:

The Board accepted Susan Workman's Land Records Management System monthly progress report. Rice is to track progress for the Board.

No action was taken at this time on the parking fund deficit as presented by Carr. Carr and Edwards were instructed by the Board to check with Joan Hastings on how to proceed with getting a notice out to all people stating that all participants in the County parking program are required to pay their proportionate share in advance by payroll deduction.

Motion made by Selph, seconded by Rice, to approve updated organizational structure for Social Services as presented by Director Norma Arnold. Upon roll call: Harris, yes; Rice, yes; Selph, yes. Motion carried.

Hazardous Waste in Tulsa County was discussed and Selph will keep the Board informed on the work with City-County Health and State.
