WHEREAS, J. Rae Owen of the City of Tulsa is willing, without any expense whatsoever on the part of Tulsa County, except as herein provided, to devote his time and attention and such other facilities as he may have and avail himself of, to ascertain the present whereabouts of the sureties upon said forfeited appearance bonds as aforesaid, their solvency and ability to pay, likewise to make such investigation of the property scheduled by said sureties on said bonds to the end that sufficient facts may be developed upon which an execution might be issued, levy made and money realized, and is willing to undertake said work and agrees to pursue such investigations in a diligent manner in consideration of which he is to receive as full compensation for his efforts in such behalf 35% percent, of such sums as and when same may be realized in cash upon any settlement made, recommended or approved by the County Attorney, John M. Goldesberry. This Resolution shall not in anywise be construed or considered as employment, or a power coupled with an interest by the authority herein given said J. Rae Owen, which he may not assign, and may be revoked at any time at the pleasure of the Board of County Commissioners either at a regular or special meeting, saving and preserving to said Owens, such rights, interests and money's which he may have earned due and payable up to the time of rescinding this resolution.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners, that said J. Rae Owen be and he hereby is authorized to put forth the efforts as are herein contemplated and set forth toward the collection of such judgments as may be placed in his hands by John M. Goldesberry, County Attorney. No expense for any purpose is to be incurred by him, on behalf of Tulsa County, but his compensation in full for all services so rendered to be such percentage of said judgments so collected or settlements made as hereinabove set forth.
