In the matter of the sale of County Poor Farm Property of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, the Honorable Luther James, Judge of the District Court of said County, having heretofore, on the 17th. day of January, 1928, made an order determining that the sale of the hereinafter described real estate is for the best interest of the said County and said order having ordered and directed this Board to sell said hereinafter described real estate; and A H Burgess, O E Robinson and A W Lucas, three disinterested freeholders of said County appointed by the said Judge of the District Court of said County, to appraise the hereinafter described real estate, having duly made and returned to this Board their appraisalment of said real estate in which they appraised the same as follows, to-wit;

- (1) The East Half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Four (4) Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Meridian, containing 80 acres, more or less; being appraised at \$16,000.00;
- (2) The West Half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Three (3) Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Meridian containing 80 acres, more or less, being appraised at \$12,000.00.

and said matter coming on for further consideration by this Board.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED and ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of said Tulsa County, that the sale of the above real estate as heretofore resolved and ordered by this Board and also so ordered by said Judge of the District Court be proceeded with, and that such sale of said real estate be had at the regular meeting of this Board on Monday, March 5th. 1928, and that notice of such sale be given as provided by law by publication in the Tulsa Tribune and Tulsa Daily Legal News for a period of thirty days, such notice to be under the signature of the members of this Board, attested by the County Clerk.
