NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That

Section Line between Sections 22-23, 26-27, 34-35,
T. 18 N., R 12 E.

Section Line between Sections 2-3, 10-11, T 17 N., R 12 E.
being the South Five (5) Miles of the Turkey Mountain
Road, and also

West $\frac{1}{4}$ mile between Section 11-14, T 17 N., R 12 E.,
and between Sections 10-15 of the same Township and
Range

be designated as a County Highway.

The following Resolution was introduced by Mr. North, seconded by Mr. Hedgecock, and declared adopted:

and Federal Drive,

The Section line between Sections 34-35, and 26-27,
T 20 N., R 13 E., locally known as Sheridan Drive
from Federal Drive North to the Dawson Pavement

be designated as a County Highway. And it is so ordered.

Motion was made by Mr. North, seconded by Mr. Hedgecock, that the County Attorney be instructed and directed to institute such proceedings as he may deem necessary to oust one FELIX C WEBB acting as Constable within and for District No. 4, Tulsa County.

The Bonds of Amos Terrell Hall, Justice of the Peace, District No. 4, and John J Tipton, Constable District No. 12, be and they are hereby approved.
