R E S O L U T I O N

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CALLING OF AN ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING UPON THE QUESTION OF ISSUING THE NEGOTIABLE COUPON BONDS OF TULSA COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A BRIDGE.

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, deem it advisable to construct a bridge over the Arkansas River east of Jenks in Sections 19 and 20, Township 18 North, Range 13 East; and

WHEREAS the estimated amount necessary for such purpose is TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$250,000) Dollars; and

WHEREAS there are not funds in the treasury sufficient for such purpose; and

WHEREAS the said Board is authorized and empowered by Section 26, Article 10 of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma and Title 69, Sections 161 to 170 both inclusive O. S. 1941 and other statutes supplementary and amendatory thereto, to issue bonds for the purpose above stated in an amount not to exceed, including the present outstanding indebtedness of said county, five per cent of the taxable property of said county as shown by the last assessment for state and county purposes; and

WHEREAS such amount is not in excess of said limit, Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY

SECTION 1.

That the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, hereby call an election to be held on the 26th day of November, 1946 in said county for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said county the following proposition:
