Section 2. The Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and the County Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute and sign said bonds and to do any and all other things required by law for the purpose of issuing, in payment of the costs of construction of the public distribution system of Water Improvement District No. 18, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, valid, legal obligations and bonds of said District.

It being necessary for the early completion of water improvements contemplated in said public distribution system of Water Improvement District No. 18 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, that this resolution become effective immediately, it is hereby declared that same shall be and become effective upon its passage and approval.
