RESOLUTION.

Be it resolved bby the Board of County Commissioners in regular session on this 15th day of January 1917, that the grade on the East approach of the Arkansas River Bridge be and the same is, hereby, established as follows:-

Commencing at the East end of the said bridge at an elevation of 652.76 feet above the sea level, the same being the elevation of the top of the rails on the said bridge, thence on a plane a distance of 373 feet to an elevation of 664 feet above sea level, creating and making a grade of 3 per cent on this approach.
