

AND WHEREAS, a similar Tax Deed to that last above described, was dated June 17, 1938, and recorded in Book 1279 at Page 303 of the records of Tulsa County's Clerk, purporting to convey the following described real estate for the net taxes sale price shown as follows, to-wit:
