RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING APPEAL  
FROM VERDICT AND JUDGMENT OF DISTRICT COURT  
OF TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, IN CASE NO. 72179,  
WRIGHT VS. TULSA COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT NO. 12  
TO SUPREME COURT OF OKLAHOMA.

WHEREAS, on March 30, 1944, there was rendered in the District  
Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in cause No. 72179, Wright Vs. Tulsa  
County Drainage District No. 12, a verdict and judgment of \$2,000.00  
in favor of plaintiff, Wright against defendant, Tulsa County Drainage  
District No. 12; and,

WHEREAS, thereafter on May 25, 1944, said District Court over-  
ruled defendant's motion for a new trial in said cause; and,

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners, as Commissioners for said  
Drainage District, are dissatisfied with the rendition of such decree  
and judgment, and believe the same to be exorbitant, excessive, unjust  
and erroneous, and have been so advised by counsel for said Drainage  
District, who also advises that same should be appealed to the Supreme  
Court of Oklahoma, in an effort to reverse same;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR SAID  
DRAINAGE DISTRICT RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that an appeal be prosecuted  
from said judgment of the District Court in said cause, to the Supreme  
Court of Oklahoma, to reverse such decree; and that Conn Linn, attorney  
for said Drainage District, prepare all necessary papers, documents and  
records, to perfect such appeal, and file and prosecute same to final  
decree, in the Supreme Court of Oklahoma; that he be and is hereby  
authorized and directed to prosecute same in the name of said Drainage  
District by its Commissioners, and do any and all things necessary to  
carry such appeal through to final decree.

Thereupon a roll call and vote being taken upon the adoption of  
said Resolution, it was moved by Commissioner Greer, and seconded by  
Commissioner Kinkaid, that same be adopted and approved as read; and  
a roll call being had thereon, the Chairman declared same unanimously  
adopted.
