### O R D E R

NOW, On this 2nd. day of April, 1923, the same being the day of the regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, the application of the TULSA PIPE LINE COMPANY to run along, under and across the highways of Tulsa County in the manner and at the places set out in the plat attached to its petition, and marked EXHIBIT "A" coming on to be heard and the Commission finding that it is necessary in the public interests that the said line be constructed, and being well and sufficiently informed in the premises,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, That the Tulsa Gas Pipe Line Company be and it is hereby authorized, empowered and permitted to lay a twelve-inch gas line along, under and over the highways of Tulsa County as in its plat marked "Exhibit A", attached to its petition indicated. That the said pipe line shall be constructed under the supervision of the County Engineer so as to cause the least damage and inconvenience to the said highways and public use thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the said Tulsa Gas Pipe Line Company shall make immediate repair of any damage done to the said highways, which said repairs shall conform to the requirements of the County Engineer and shall be made under his supervision, and the said Tulsa Gas Pipe Line Company by its application and acceptance of this order agrees and binds itself to make such repairs as may be necessary by reason of its construction of said pipe line and shall pay for the same and agrees to hold the County of Tulsa harmless from all damage arising from the construction, maintenance and operation of the said gas pipe line.

Gentlemen:-

The Dahlstrom Improvement Co. this day took up bonds of Park View Drainage District No. 2 in the sum of \$12600.97 and have asked for stakes on Monday, the 2nd. of April for construction purposes. I understand from them that they have placed all the bonds, and the work will commence at once in earnest.

In the development of this District an understanding was reached that a right of way for a road would be deeded the County, North and South through the center of Section 4, which would call for a bridge over the main ditch to be constructed by the County, the right of way having been so deeded. Also, on the Section line between Sections 3 and 4 a County Bridge will be required, and one on the center of Section 3, all as shown on the plans as approved by your Honorable Board. On the paved road in the water works ground a bridge exists which will need some adjusting to meet the requirements of the ditch when completed.

This comprises all the obligations the County has assumed in the matter, and since active work is to start at once, I recommend your Honorable Board instruct Your County Engineer to make the necessary plans to meet these requirements.
