ORDER

NOW, On this the 21st. day of July, 1930, on due consideration of the application heretofore filed by the GULF PIPE LINE COMPANY OF PENNSYLVANIA, a corporation, praying for permission to lay a ten inch pipe line for the transmission of crude oil and its products inninter-state commerce and in connection therewithbuild, operate and maintain a telegraph and telephone line along, across, upon, over and under the public highways of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, the Board after considering said application finds that the same should be granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the GULF PIPE LINE COMPANY OF PENNSYLVANIA, a corporation, be and the same is hereby granted the right, privilege and authority to construct its said ten inch pipe line, and in connection therewith its telepehone and telegraph line over, under, across along and upon any and all public highways in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, said pipe line and said telephone and telegraph system to be put down, erected and constructed in such manner as not to interfere with the use and safety of said highways for public use and traffic, and where the bed of said highways is disturbed to restore the same to the same condition that thuy are now and so as to render the said highways as safe for public use and travel as if said highways had not been disturbed.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, for the purpose of constructing a highway through and acress certain land in Section Thirteen (13), Township Nineteen (19), North, Range Twelve (12), East, it is necessary to acquire a strip of land particularly described as follows:

"A strip of land for right of way for highway purposes in Lot Seven (7) In Section Thirteen (13), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) east, Tulsa, County Oklahoma, desceibed as follows: Beginning at a point on the North line of the County road right of way on the south line of said Section 13, said point being 24.75 feet north of and 73.0 feet west of the Quarter Section corner on the south side of Section 13; thence North 10°-03' W. 497 feet to a point, thence N. 14° -59' W 442 feet more or less, to a point on the south line of the Midland Valley Railroad right of way; thence in a southwesterly direction along said south line of the Midland Valley Railroad right of way 118 feet, more or less, to a point on the Government Meander line on the left bank of the Arkansas River; thence S 17°-00' E along said meander line 434 feet, more or less to a Government meander corner; thence S 8°-00' E along the meander line 473 feet, more or less, to a point on the North line of the County road right of way on the south line of Section 13, thence East along said north line of the road right of way 119 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, containing 2.32 acres, more or less"

AND, WHEREAS, Tulsa County has been unable to affect an amicable settlement in the matter of the said strip of land owned by the Estate of E Roger Kemp.

AND, WHEREAS, it is necessary to acquire said strip of land for right of way purposes by condemniation proceedings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Attorney, in the name of this Board for an on behalf thereof, be and he is hereby instructed to institute condemnation proceedings in the District Court of this County for the purpose of condemning said above described tract of land for County highway purposes.
