RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Raymond D. WHEREAS, suit was instituted by the County Attorney against said Raymond D. Slattery and his sureties, George E. Thouvenell and Cola L. Thouvenell, in the District Court of Tulsa County, Civil Case No. 79,866, and said sureties have offered \$800.00, in settlement of said bail bond forfeiture.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that said offer of said sureties is accepted, and that Elmer W. Adams, County Attorney, is hereby authorized to accept the sum of \$800.00, in full settlement of the claim on said bond forfeiture, and to deduct 25% of said amount for his fee as allowed by law, and to pay the balance in to the Court Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
