The chairman declared the meeting open for any business that might properly come before it, and the secretary presented the bond of W. M. McCullough, elected sheriff of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, said bond being in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars, (\$5,000.00) executed by the National Surety Company of New York, and upon due consideration of said bond of W. M. McCullough, a motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that said bond be approved. Thereupon a vote was taken, and the chairman declared the motion duly carried.

The secretary then presented the bond of W. B. Williams, County Judge, re-elected, said bond being in the amount of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars, with J. S. Shaver, J. M. Crutchfield and J. S. Hopping and Chas. Page as sureties. The Bond was read before and considered by the Board, and motion was duly made and seconded that said bond of W. B. Williams be by the Board approved, which motion duly carried.

The official bond of O. D. Lawson, elected County Clerk, within and for the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, was then presented to the Board. Said bond being executed by the National Surety Company of New York, in the amount of five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars as by law provided. Upon final consideration by the Board, on motion of W. L. North, which motion was duly seconded by Commissioner F. M. Wooden, the bond was approved, all votes being cast for the motion, the same was declared carried, and by the chairman ordered spread upon the minutes of the meeting.

The bond of W. F. Seaver, elected County Attorney which bond is in the amount of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, executed by the Southern Surety Company of Des Moines, Iowa was filed with and approved by O. D. Lawson, County Clerk, as by law provided.

The bond of Frances Harvey, elected Court Clerk within and for the County of Tulsa State of Oklahoma, executed by the Lion Bonding and Surety Company of Omaha, Nebraska, in the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) was then presented to the Board, and upon consideration of said bond, a motion was made by F. M. Wooden and seconded by Ed Dalton, that said bond be and the same was thereby approved, said motion having received all of the votes cast.
