

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Highway Department is in need of a Ford Station Wagon for use of the Field Crew, and has found that Fred Jones, Tulsa, Oklahoma, has a used 1950 Ford Station wagon, 8 cylinder, Motor No. BOMF116277, that can be purchased for One Thousand<sup>Seven</sup> Hundred Fifteen Dollars and Sixty-three cents, (\$1,715.63.)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioner be authorized to purchase used Ford Station Wagon, and the County Highway Department be authorized to draw a claim to the Fred Jones Company, in the sum of One thousand seven hundred fifteen dollars and sixty-three cents (\$1,715.63), payable from the account Number 6-B designated as Highway Equipment of the County Highway Department General Fund.
