

Motion was made by Ira Short, that the claim of Walter Duckett in the amount of One Thousand(\$1,000.00) Dollars for the arrest and conviction of Volney Davis be and the same is hereby allowed. Motion was duly seconded by F.M.Wooden. The following vote was cast: Geo.E.Gilmore, Aye, F.M.Wooden, Aye, and Ira Short, Aye.

Motion was made by Geo.E.Gilmore, seconded by F.M.Wooden, that the claim of C.C.Franks, and associates, in the amount of Five Thousand(\$5,000.00) Dollars for the arrest and conviction of Roy Jones, Fred Etheridge, <sup>Frank Reed</sup> Albert Slain and C.W.Handy be and the same is hereby allowed. The following vote was cast: Geo.E.Gilmore, Aye, F.M.Wooden Aye and Ira Short "Aye". Motion was duly carried.

Motion was made by F.M.Wooden, seconded by Ira Short, that Mrs. Myrtle Vaughn be granted an allowance of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per month on and after April 1st, 1923. This allowance was made at the request of Tulsa County Humane Society, by Mrs.McConnell.

At a regularly adjourned meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, held on the 9th. day of April, 1923, in the office of said Commissioners, in the Court House, in the City of Tulsa, the following Resolution was introduced by F.M.Wooden, who moved its adoption, and the motion to adopt was duly seconded by Ira Short, and the Resolution ordered read:

#### R E S O L U T I O N.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the several Townships within the County of Tulsa, have Supplemental and Additional Appropriation, General Fund, for the remainder of the current year.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That Fred Parkinson, State Examiner and Inspector, be requested to prepare Financial Statement, as at the close of business as of March 31st. 1923, in the General Funds of the following named Townships:

Jenks Township, Owasso Township, Red Fork Township, Skiatook Township,  
Wekiwa Township

and, application for additional and supplemental appropriation for the remainder of the current fiscal year.

Upon, roll call the following members voted "AYE" Geo.E.Gilmore, F.M.Wooden and Ira Short.

The motion having received the majority of the votes was declared carried and ordered made of record in the minutes of the proceedings of this Board, and that a certified copy thereof be transmitted to Hon. Fred Parkinson, State Examiner and Inspector, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

Adjournment ordered until 2 o'clock P.M.

Meeting was called to order with the following members present: Ira Short, F.M.Wooden and O.G.Weaver, County Clerk. Geo.E.Gilmore, absent.

#### R E S O L U T I O N.

Motion was made by Ira Short, and seconded by F.M.Wooden, that the County Engineer be instructed to construct concrete inverted drainage crossing at section intersections along the concrete roads where, in his judgment, the same are needed for the protection of the paved roads. Also, to construct a six (6) foot culvert between Sections Six (6) and Seven (7) Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East in Dawson Township at a cost not to exceed \$450.00
