The following Resolution was introduced by Mr.North, who moved its adoption, said motion being seconded by Mr.Bohnefeld. the Chairman ordered the Resolution read:

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Sec. 9988, Chap. 85, C O S provides that, "All section lines in the State are hereby declared public highways. The public highways shall not be less than thirty three, nor more than sixty-six feet in width, according to the dedication, reservation, condemnation thereof".

AND, WHEREAS, An Act of Congress, Approved July 1, 1902, ratified August 7,1902, (Cherokee Allotment Agreement) provides, among other things, that "Public Highways or roads two(2) rods in width, being onerod on each side of the Section lines, may be established along all section lines without any condemnation being paid therefor, and all allotees, purchasers and others shall take the title to such lands subject to this provision".

AND, WHEREAS, in carrying out a made-work program in Tulsa County which has been approved by the Governor of the State of Oklahoma, with loans from Reconstruction Finance Corporation, it becomes necessary to open various section lines in the Cherokee Nation which have not previously been opened as a public highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the following Section lines be declared open and a public highway two rods wide be established thereon:

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"Between Sections 8-17, T 20 N., R 13 E.

" 5-6, T 20 N. R 14 #.

" 32-33, T 20 NI, R 14 E.

" 1-36 T 20-21 N., R 12 E.

" 6-31 T 20-21 N., R 14 E.

" 35-36 T 21 N., R 13 E.

" 4-9 T 22 N., R 14 E.
