Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners met at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Curtis Greer, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, that \$1,500 be allocated to the Welfare department for groceries for the month of July, 1941. Motion seconded by Commissioner Greer, and upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, that the following depository agreements, be and the same are hereby approved:

Between American Exchange Bank of Collinsville and Bd. of County Commissioners
Between Bank of Commerce of Janks and Bd. of County Commissioners
Between First Nat'l. Bank of Broken Arrow and Bd. of County Commissioners
Between Peoples State Bank of Tulsa and Bd. of Co. Commissioners

Motion seconded by Commissioner Greer, and upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, that the following letter be sent to the Mayor and City Commissioners, to-wit:

This will notify your honorable board that we are turning the colored municipal back to the City of Tulsa. We want it understood that it is impossible for us to move all the sick at once from that hospital to another, but when the hospital is entirely vacated we will notify you.
