To the Board of County Commissioners,  
Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

The undersigned respectfully requests permission to cross the bridge over the Arkansas River, located in section 14, township 19 north, Range Eleven (11) East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and generally known as the Sand Springs bridge, with a line of poles and wires for the transmission of electricity.

Your petitioner submits herewith contract covering the permit to use the bridge for the purpose above indicated, which we trust will be found satisfactory.

Should the permission be granted and the contract submitted herewith be approved, your petitioner requests that proper resolution be passed granting the permission to use the bridge and authorizing the execution of the contract.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that a contract be entered into by and between the County of Tulsa, by its Board of County Commissioners and the Oklahoma Gas and electric Company for the use of the Arkansas River Bridge between Tulsa and West Tulsa for the transportation of gas and electric current by means of poles, wires, conduits, etc., which agreement is as follows to wit:

"THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into in duplicate on this 3rd day of January, 1921, by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, acting for and in behalf of said Tulsa County, party of the first part and the Oklahoma, Gas and Electric Company, a corporation under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That Whereas said Tulsa County is the owner of a certain bridge crossing the Arkansas River, and located in Section Fourteen (14), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Eleven (11) East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and otherwise known as the Sand Springs Bridge, and

WHEREAS, the said Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company is desirous of crossing said bridge with a line of poles and wires for the transmission of electricity, and whereas the said Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, acting for said County are willing that such crossing should be made subject to the terms, conditions and agreements hereinafter set out;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00 Dollars by the party of the second part ~~paid~~ to the party of the first part in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for and in consideration of the agreements, matters and things hereinafter set out, have agreed and do hereby agree as follows:

1st: The said Party of the first part does hereby give permission to said party of the second part, its successors and assigns to cross said bridge with a line of poles and wires for the transmission of electricity so long as the said bridge may remain where it now is, subject however, to the following express limitations, conditions and terms:

(a) Said party of the second part shall erect said poles and wires in accordance with the specifications and blue prints hereto attached and made a part hereof, and identified hereby and referred to herein as "Exhibit A", and shall erect said poles and wires under and subject to the supervision and orders of the County Engineer.

(b) Said party of the second part shall hold the party of the first part and the individuals, composing the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, harmless against any and all damages arising out of the erection of maintenance of said line of poles and wires.

(c) Should it at any time in the opinion of the party of the first part, become necessary to remove said line of poles and wires in order to insure the safety of said bridge or permit the widening of the roadway of said bridge, said party of the second part shall after thirty days written notice to it, proceed to remove at its own expense said line of poles and wires without unnecessary delay.

(d) This permit is granted subject to any rights of a like character which may have been previously granted where such rights are now actually being exercised.

2nd:- The party of the second part hereby accepts the permission herein granted subject to the terms and conditions hereinabove set out.
