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Report from the Board of Directors of Water Improvement District No. 19, together with the report of the Consulting Engineers of the final and complete estimate of the cost of said Water Improvement District were presented and resolution adopting the estimate of the cost made by the engineers and approved by the Board of Directors and appointing three disinterested freeholders from the body of the County to act as appraisers to appraise and apportion the benefits to the several lots, parcels and tracts of land in said Water Improvement District was, upon motion by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, unanimously passed.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Water Improvement District No. 19, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has passed and filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, a complete and accurate statement of the cost of the entire public distribution system of Water Improvement District No. 19, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 7, Title 82, O. S. 1941, as amended (pp. 771 et seq) which is as follows:

Engineers Fee	15,267.78
Cost of appraising, easements, advertising, legal, printing and other expenses incurred or to be incurred by the Board of Directors incident to said improvement	15,209.45
Final Total Cost	\$ 265,366.23

WHEREAS, after full consideration thereof and upon being fully advised in the premises, said statement is found to be correct;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that said statement of the cost of the public distribution of Water Improvement District No. 19, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, as heretofore filed with this Board and as hereinabove set forth, be and the same is found to be correct and is in all respects adopted and confirmed; that Ralph Wingate, J. G. McGuire and Clair R. Miller, who are three disinterested freeholders from the body of said Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and who are not owners of any property to be assessed are hereby appointed to constitute a Board of Appraisers to appraise and apportion the benefits to be received by the construction of the public distribution system to the several lots, tracts and parcels of land in said Water Improvement District No. 19, which said tracts, lots and parcels of land are described in a schedule hereto attached and which said schedule is referred to and made a part of this resolution

That said appraisers shall, within five (5) days after being notified of their appointment, and taking and subscribing their oath to make true and impartial appraisalment and apportionment, proceed to perform all such acts and things in the premises as by law they are or will be required and empowered to do; and said appraisers shall make return and report of such appraisalment and apportionment to this Board of County Commissioners.
