#### R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 44 of the Extraordinary Session of the Ninth Oklahoma Legislature provides, among other things, for the designation of County Highways, and

WHEREAS, it becomes necessary to designate a certain section of road as a County Highway and improve the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that

"The Section line between sections 1-2, 11-12;

13-14; 23-24; Township 20 North, Range 12 East

be designated as a part of the Tulsa County Highway System.

#### R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

SECTION 1. That said County purchase from Midland Sand Company, an Oklahoma Corporation, that certain property in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and those certain rights described in the attached form of instrument entitled "Easement" and hereby made a part of this Resolution AT AND for a price of \$8,000.00 to be paid by said Tulsa County to said Midland Sand Company in cash on the delivery to the Chairman of said Board of Commissioners, of said "Easement" executed by said Midland Sand Company.

SECTION 2. That said Board of Commissioners, through its Chairman is hereby authorized to accept from said Midland Sand Company the conveyance of said land and rights described in said "Easement" on the terms and conditions in said instrument set forth.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof, this resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

PASSED and approved, by unanimous vote of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and the Emergency Clause passed and approved separately on this 4th day of August, 1930.
