And we direct the County Clerk to issue a Certificate of Error (on each one separately) directing the County Treasurer to cancel the taxes and to issue a Certificate of Assessment (on each one separately) re-assessing the within property, provided, however, that the Certificates of Error and the Certificates of Assessment re-assessing said property shall not be issued until the expiration of ten (10) days from the date of this order and, provided further, that said Certificates of Assessment shall not be issued if any protest be filed within said ten day period until the issues of said protest be determined. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Gray, Yes; Hopkins, Yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the following Certificates of Error and Certificates of Re-assessment be and the same are hereby ordered cancelled for the reason that said Certificates have been held in abeyance for payment of taxes for a period of sixty days and said payments have not been made.
