ELECTION PROCLAMATION.

Proclamation is hereby given that under and by virtue of Section 26, Article 10 of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma and Title 69, Sections 161 to 170 both inclusive, Oklahoma Statutes 1941, and laws supplementary and amendatory thereto, and a resolution duly adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, on the 29th day of May, 1950, an election will be held in said county on the 4th day of July, 1950, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said county the following proposition:

"Shall the Board of County Commissioners issue the negotiable coupon bonds of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, in the sum of NINE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$900,000.00) DOLLARS, to mature serially as follows; \$50,000.00 each year, beginning three years from their date and ending twenty years from their date, bearing interest at the rate of not to exceed three per centum per annum, payable semi-annually, for the purpose of providing funds for the purpose of building and constructing permanent state and county roads."

The ballots used at said election shall state the proposition above set forth, and shall also contain the words:

(An elector desiring to vote for the bond issue shall stamp or mark "X" in the square immediately preceding the work "Yes"; and if he desired to vote against the bond issue he shall stamp or mark an "X" in the square immediately preceding the work "No")
