AGREEMENT.

This agreement made and entered into this 5th day of February 1917, by and between the County Commissioners of the City of Tulsa, County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, party of the first part and the Tulsa World, a weekly newspaper party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the stipulations, covenants and agreements hereinafter to be kept and performed by the parties hereto, it is agreed as follows:

First: Said party of the first part does hereby agree to let unto said party of the second party and have second party do all the printing and publishing of all Commissioners' proceedings and all other legal printing which is to be done for said Tulsa County, placed either directly or indirectly by the County Commissioners, or otherwise including both personal and realty delinquent tax lists by the county treasurer from the date of this contract to the 31st day of December 1918.

Second: In consideration of the letting of all the printing, meaning and full copy, which is to be done directly or indirectly by said party of the first part to the said party of the second part as above provided, party of the second part hereby agrees to publish all of the above printing in the Tulsa Daily World a weekly newspaper published in the City of Tulsa, County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, of general circulation for which the charges shall be, as follows:

Commissioners proceedings free, and all other legal printing to be charged at the legal rate so established by the State of Oklahoma.
