

The following is a contract entered into by and between J.M. Jackson, undertaker of Norman, Oklahoma, for the burial of the insane dead, who die at Norman, Oklahoma, committed from Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and the Board of Tulsa County Commissioners.

January 1st, 1917.

TO THE HON. BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS,  
TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA.

Gentlemen:-

With regards to the burial of the insane dead, who die at Norman, Oklahoma, committed from your county, we beg leave to hand you herewith a copy of a contract used by the counties for that purpose.

We offer, for the sum of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars each, to take charge of the body, provide coffin, grave in cemetery and pay all expenses of burial in ground we purchased in which to bury all unclaimed dead.

We agree, in each instance, to make an earnest effort to locate relatives of deceased and persuade them, if found, to pay the burial expenses.

We frequently are able to save counties, with whom we have contracts, the expense of burial of bodies, and will attempt to do so in all instances.
