

Monday, February 19th 1917.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular adjourned session, Monday, February 19th 1917, at 10 o'clock, present W.L.North Vice Chairman of the Board, and R.A.Martin member, with Lewis Cline County Clerk .

After the roadwork claims were audited and allowed, the following resolutions were made. (See Claims)

A resolution was passed by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County Oklahoma on Monday February 19th 1917, making it the duty of the Township road superintendents to look after all dragging on and in their respective townships and be general superintendent of said dragging.

A motion was made by W.L.North and seconded by R.A.Martin that the County Map designating the Justice Peace Districts as laid off by the County Clerk^{be} and is hereby adopted. Motion prevailed.

A motion was made ^{that} S.W.Mitchell County Engineer be instructed to investigate the road way and section line in and around the Texas Refinery between Secs.15 and 22, 19-12, and have said sections lines opened for travel at the earliest possible date. Motion prevailed.

The petition of A.C.Stivers of Jenks Township was received and a motion was made by W.L.North and seconded by R.A.Martin that A.C.Stivers be appointed road supervisor of Jenks Township. Motion prevailed.

The Depository Bond of the Planters National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma was filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, and approved.

The continuation certificate of the Exchange National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma, was filed with the County Clerk and approved by the Commissioners.

The Depository bond of the Planters National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma, was filed with the County Clerk of Tulsa County, and approved by the Board of County Commissioners. Bond was made in the sum of \$30,000.00 with the London and Lancashire Indemnity Company of America as surety.
