Motion was made by F.M. Wooden, seconded by Ira Short, that the County Engineer be requested to open Section line running from Hale Station, on the Sand Springs Car Line, north to the Osage County Line, or between Sections 3 and 4, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, and that the Engineer be instructed to request the Missouri, Kansas and Texas Railway Company to provide a crossing at this place. Motion carried.

The following Resolution was introduced by Ira Short, who moved its adoption and the motion was seconded by F.M. Wooden.

BE IT RESOLVED, By this Board, that it is to the best interest of Dawson Township that special attention be given to the public highway between Sections 31-32, 29-32 and 28-29, Township 20 North, Range 14 East, to the end that said highway be permanently improved at as early a date as possible. That said road particularly serves the stone crushing industries at Garnet, and is the logical route for trucks from the City of Tulsa to said rock crushers; that the same is a mail route and in addition thereto as said improvements are made, be of special benefit to the schools of said district. That the County Engineer be instructed to develop said road as finances will permit.

ENGINEER'S REPORT.

Hon. County Commissioners,
Tulsa, County, Oklahoma.

Gentlemen:-

Pursuant to your Resolution of the 4th. day of April 1923, I beg to advise you that I have under way the matter of the surveys and plans for the improvement by grading and draining Section "Q1" and Miles "1a" and "2a" of Section "Q" of the State Highway, and in view of the fact that certain portions of this work seems favorable for grading with the County heavy equipment, that it is not to the best advantage to contract all this work, so therefore, it is my recommendation that an employment contract be entered into between the County and Mr. John Cronin, whereby the County employs Mr. Cronin and his teaming outfit to perform this work. I have taken the matter up with Mr. Cronin, and we have agreed substantially upon the condition
